Thursday, September 20th 1888

Article referring to The Whitechapel Murder:

Resumption of the inquiry of the murder of Mary Ann Chapman who was found murdered in the back yard of 29 Hanbury street, Spitalfields. The court having been cleared of all women and boys, the witnesses proceeded to give medical and surgical evidence totally unfit for publication of the deliberate, successful and apparently scientific manner in which the poor woman had been mutilated.

The foreman stated that the reward of Mr.S. Montagu MP for Whitechapel, of £100 had been posted about, but the Government did not, as the Coroner previously stated now offer rewards.

Additionally, the newspaper also includes a story regarding the strike of 160 workmen building the Eiffel Tower who were demanding an additional 20 centimes per hour for the increased altitude they were working at and the accompanying dangers!

The Times, October 12th 1888

The East End Murders:

Mr. S.F. Langham the City Coroner resumed the inquest at the mortuary in Golden Lane respecting the death of Catherine Eddows, otherwise Conway or Kelly who was murdered in Mitre Square on the morning of Sunday 30th September.

First witness Dr. George William Sequeira answered questions by Mr. Crawford the City Solicitor:

Qu. Have you formed any opinion that the murderer had any design with respect to any particular part?

Ans. I have formed the opinion that he had no particular design on any particular organ

Qu. Judging from the injuries inflicted do you think he was possessed of great anatomical skill?

Ans. No I do not

There are several witnesses statements and reference is made to a phrase chalked on a wall at the site and the spelling of a key word. The phrase was removed by police on the day for fear of increasing racial tension in an increasing tense atmosphere.

The jury at the inquiry consulted for a couple of minutes before giving a verdict of "Wilful murder by some person unknown"

The controversial phrase was "The Jews are the men that will not be blamed for nothing" it did however have two different spellings given by two different policemen "Jews" and "Juwes"

John Moffat Mein was born in 1863 in St Cuthbert's Parish, Edinburgh, Scotland, the son of Henry and Jane Mein. He enlisted in the British Army at Edinburgh on 7th January 1881 and was posted to the 19th Hussars as a private (service number 2097).

Mein served in Egypt and the Sudan as part of the Gordon Relief Expedition and was present at the Battle of Abu Klea. For this service, he was awarded the Egypt Medal with clasps 'The Nile 1881-85' and 'Abu Klea'.

After returning to the United Kingdom, Mein left active service but remained in the Army Reserve. On 1st October 1895, he was reported absent without leave from Bilymerign and was subsequently declared a deserter. His name and description appeared in The Police Gazette on 21st April 1896. He was described as 5 feet 7 inches tall, of pale complexion, with brown hair and hazel eyes. His occupation was listed as photographer, and he was noted to have an old cut on the left thumb and a burn mark on the right foot.

Having left England, Mein travelled to South Africa and entered the Cape Colony. He is noted to have taken part in the Jameson Raid of 1895-1896 in 'B' Troop, before

later serving during the Boer War with the 2nd Imperial Light Horse. For his service, he was awarded the Queen's South Africa Medal with clasps "Cape Colony," "Orange Free State," and "Transvaal."

Mein later moved to Rhodesia, where he continued working as a photographer. In 1906 he joined the Manica Lodge in Umtali as a Freemason, resigning in 1908. He subsequently returned to South Africa.

During the Great War, he enlisted once more, joining the King's Royal Rifle Corps. Serving as a rifleman with the 2nd Battalion, he was wounded in action and evacuated to No. 3 Stabilisation Hospital at Rouen, France. He died of his wounds on 9th October 1918 and is buried in St Sever Extension Cemetery, Rouen.

Remarkably, John Moffat Mein died as a combat soldier at the age of 55, having served in three wars and participated in the famous Jameson Raid.
