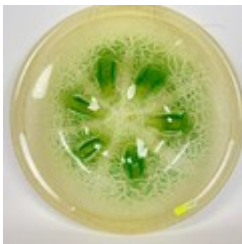

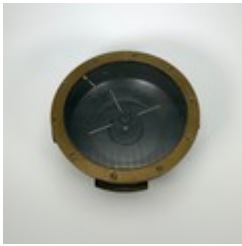

Henry William Adams was born in his family seat of Ansty Hall in 1805. At the age of 18, he was commissioned as an ensign for the 12th Regiment of Foot. He purchased the rank of lieutenant, then captain, and later major. After 17 years, Adams purchased the rank of Lieutenant Colonel in the 18th Royal Irish Regiment of Foot. He commanded the regiment during the First Opium War, seeing action at the First Capture of Chusan (July 1840), Battle of Canton (May 1841), Battle of Amoy (August 1841), Second Capture of Chusan (October 1841), Battle of Ningpo (March 1842), and Battle of Chinkiang (July 1842).

He was appointed a Commander of the Order of the Bath in October 1841 and transferred as a Lieutenant Colonel to the 49th Regiment of Foot. On the 21st of February, he was appointed Brigadier General and was in command of the 2nd Division. He fought in the Crimea, and while defending a position against a Russian assault at the Battle of Inkerman, for which he was mentioned in dispatches, his horse was shot from beneath him, leading to him being mortally wounded. He was taken to the Florence Nightingale hospital in Scutari, where his wife nursed him, but he died a week later from his wounds. He was buried in the family vault in the churchyard at Ansty; his wife later employed a renowned architect, Sir George Gilbert Scott, who in 1856, designed and built the tower that replaced the bell turret that still stands today at St James's church, Ansty.

Henry Rainier Adams, great-great-nephew of Henry William Adams, was born in July 1880 and reached the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. He served in notable

campaigns and was the recipient of medals such as both the Queen's and King's South Africa medals, DSO and various WWI medals. He served with the RGA until he was discharged in the summer of 1930. Originally serving with the militia in 1899, he commissioned into the regular army in 1900. He served with distinction during the early months of the First World War and is reputed to have taken part in numerous rear guard actions during the Great Retreat/Battle of Mons. Over the course of the war, he was mentioned in dispatches three times, served as an acting Lieutenant Colonel while still at the rank of Major, and was awarded the DSO. After the war, he served in India, and during this time, his request for a promotion to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel was denied, not due to his own fault, but due to the army's financial state after the war. He appealed this decision but was once again denied. At the time of his retirement, the army finally offered him his promotion but could only offer him a major's retirement pay. He was later awarded the Defence Medal for his efforts during WWII.
